If you want to hang at Common Grounds, please sign the sign-up sheet at the WBAG meeting. If more than five (5) people sign up, names will be picked as in a lottery. If you are hanging already and want to sign up again, you will only be entered in the "lottery" if there are less than five people signed up for that hanging.

The owners requested Louisiana or New Orleans themes but not exclusively as long as the owner approves. Paintings must be original (not prints, giclees, etc.) but may be paintings done in class, workshops, etc. Paintings must be no larger than 16" X 20" and must have wire hangings.

Artists must have business cards attached showing title and price. The chairperson has the discretion to move paintings around.

Artists selected may bring 6-8 paintings depending on the size.

Any artist scheduled to bring paintings on the assigned date, or failing to take down paintings on the assigned date, will not be allowed to hang for six months.

*Change out will be every other month on the second Thursday as per the following: December 13, 2018, February 14, 2019, April 11, 2019, and June 13, 2019.*
